The Gold Industry Group's National Gold Education Program provides teachers with access to a unique learning opportunity for students to discover Australia's gold sector.

Fun and engaging interactive STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) activities, delivered by passionate industry professionals, will excite students about gold, its importance, relevance and opportunities.

## PRIMARY ACTIVITY

Lifting a gold bar – students work in teams, putting together and designing pulley systems to lift a small weight while learning more about the gold industry and how important safety is. Recommended for Years 4-6.

## SECONDARY ACTIVITY

Exploring for gold – students learn about gold ore formations and interact with a series of geological and geophysical maps to choose an area of interest for gold mining. Recommended for Years 7-10.

Each interactive one-hour session can be presented to a single class of up to 32 students at a time. This program is available for free at schools across Australia.

### Gold Class Facilitators

The sessions are conducted by passionate gold industry professionals, trained to deliver a unique approach to learning about Australia's gold sector. Facilitators will also provide students with insight into their role and career experiences as well as industry opportunities.
